2009 National JOAD Indoor and Outdoor Tournament Season:

2009 JOAD National Indoor Season

The **2009 World Indoor Team Trials** takes place on January 2-4, 2009 in Dubuque, Iowa.

The trials will select the USAA team that will compete in the FITA Indoor World Championship in Poland. The 12 member USAA Juniors team consists of 3-Jr Boy Compound, 3-Jr Boy Recurve, 3-Jr Girl Compound, 3-Jr Girl Recurve, archers.

The next two are unique opportunities to make one trip and take part in two indoor championship tourneys. **JOAD Indoor National Championship** and **USAA/NAA National Indoor Championship** take place together at 12+ locations across the country. The tourneys take place in late February and March.

The **JOAD Indoor National Championship** is a single 600 round at 18 meters.

It is JOAD style which means that for Bowman and Cubs compete and score as follows:

Recurve bow JOAD Bowmans and Cubs shoot on a 60 cm face and score the outer 10 ring. Compound bow JOAD Bowmans and Cubs shoot on a 40 cm face and score the outer ten ring. (per 2007 JOAD Handbook page 14-15) <http://www.usaarcheryjoad.org/files/2007JOADHandbook.pdf>

Cadets and Juniors use the same target face size and scoring as seniors.

The **USAA/NAA National Indoor Championship** is a 2x600 round (1200) at 18 meters. Bowmans, Cubs, Cadets and Juniors use the same target face size and scoring as seniors. All use a 40 cm face.

All recurve bow archers shall score the outer ten ring. (2008 FITA Rule Book 3, 8.2.1.1)

All compound bow archers shall score the inner ten ring. (8.2.1.3)

2009 JOAD National Outdoor Season

The JOAD National outdoor season quickly follows in April where JOAD are invited to compete with and as seniors at USAT qualifiers.

The competitive JOAD national outdoor season begins with the **Jr World Team Trials/SI Cup** in Carbondale, Illinois. Archers will be traveling in April to compete on the first days of May to qualifying take part in round robins matches. The Youth World Championship and Youth Olympic Qualifying event will take place in the **USA** in Ogden, Utah in mid July.

JOAD National Championship will take place over the 4th of July in Pennsylvania. The tournament selects the JOAD National Champions.

The USAA season traditionally finishes with week long USAA/NAA **National Target Championship**, in August, location to be determined.

More: There are also opportunities for Cadets and Junior to take part in International Tournament. The FITA Continental Association for the Americas, COPARCO, will conduct six World Ranking Tournaments. Many offer Junior and some offer Cadet. These tourneys are ideal ways to gain valuable international experience. JOAD can also compete as adults.
